Subject: Speakman Drive Long-Term Care Homes – Sanitary Sewer Replacement and Improvement

Dear residents,

Last summer and fall, we let you know about Sanitary Sewer Replacement and Improvement work taking place on Hadwen Road and Speakman Drive. This work was necessary to increase capacity in the sanitary sewer system to accommodate the new long-term care homes on Speakman Drive, and upgrade the wastewater system capacity and reliability as part of the Region of Peel's State of Good Repair program.

On May 5, we shared with you that the remainder of work was resuming on May 9. The purpose of this notice is to let you know the work was delayed in May, and will now begin on June 23, 2022.

Most of the sanitary sewer upgrade work has been completed, with the upgraded sanitary sewer in place and operational for several months. The work beginning this week includes concrete curb and sidewalk replacement (damaged areas only), landscaping and roadway asphalt. EllisDon does not anticipate any major excavation or road closures. All work will be completed with lane closures and traffic control flagging. It is expected to take three weeks to complete.

Hours of Work

The hours of work will take place from 7:00am - 7:00pm.

Potential Impacts

- **For businesses** in the area, there will be daytime lane closures where the work is taking place. There will be no driveway closures during the day, as asphalt paving and concrete repair of driveway approaches will be coordinated with the respective property owners.
- **For residential neighbours**, there should be minimal impacts. The work taking place is located within the Sheridan Park business centre, so there should be no major noise impacts to residential neighbours. Similar to the start of the project, we ask that you please take alternate routes of travel, whenever possible, to avoid delays. Additionally, MiWay transit will not be affected.
