Dear neighbours,

We are writing to you today to provide an update on the Noise Bylaw Exemption application for the long-term care homes project on Speakman Drive in Mississauga.

Noise Bylaw Exemption Application:

The City of Mississauga has approved a new Noise Bylaw Exemption in response to an application submitted by our construction partner, EllisDon, in January 2023. The new exemption will go into effect March 2, 2023 and end on July 10, 2023. This exemption allows construction to take place outside of the standard bylaw hours (Monday to Saturday, 7am-7pm), permitting construction between the hours of 7pm - 11pm (Monday to Friday). These hours are consistent with the previous Noise Bylaw Exemptions that have been in place.

Trillium Health Partners (THP) and EllisDon are committed to working closely together with the City of Mississauga to minimize the impact of the noise bylaw exemption on the surrounding community and will continue to take steps to minimize disruption to nearby residents:

- The majority of both homes are now fully enclosed. Most of the remaining work will take place on the interior of the buildings, while the landscaping will take place outdoors.
- Lighting and noise is reduced after 7pm by directing lighting away from neighbouring homes, placing site lights on timers and avoiding parking in the east parking lot.
- Remaining tower cranes on East and West areas of the property will be removed in early spring 2023.

Future Town Halls:

We are planning a town hall for the community in spring 2023. We will share details in the coming weeks.
